# SIU Credit Union **2023 Scholarship Application**



## The Program

SIU Credit Union awards annual scholarships to help members throughout southern Illinois continue their education. A college education is one of the most important investments a person can make and SIU Credit Union is dedicated to helping its members with that investment.

Ten (10) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for the 2023-24 academic year. Scholarship recipients will be notified in May 2023 and will be announced to the rest of the Credit Union membership in a future publication. A check will be made payable to the recipient. The check will be presented to the recipients during a May presentation at the Carbondale East branch (395 N. Giant City Road) of SIU Credit Union.

## **Eligibility**

- 1. Applicant or the applicant's legal guardian must be a SIU Credit Union member in good standing and maintain that membership status throughout the duration of the award to apply for the scholarship. A member in good standing is defined as one with a minimum balance of \$5 in his or her account and no loan delinquencies. Membership is open to any of the following individuals:
  - Anyone who lives or works in the following Illinois counties: Alexander, Clinton, Edwards, Franklin, Gallatin, Hamilton, Hardin, Jackson, Jefferson, Johnson, Marion, Massac, Monroe, Perry, Pope, Pulaski, Randolph, Saline, Union, Wabash, Washington, Wayne, White, or Williamson.
  - Immediate family members of existing members (parents, spouse, children, siblings, grandchildren, or grandparents).
  - Anyone who works or belongs to one of our select employer groups (SEGs) or eligible associations. See our website for a full listing.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior enrolling into a two or four year college; community college student transferring into a four-year university; or adult student returning to college.
- 3. Applicant must fully complete the Scholarship Application and return it to SIU Credit Union with all appropriate support material by the **March 31, 2023** deadline for the application to be considered by the committee.
- 4. SIU Credit Union employees, committee members, board members and their immediate family members are not eligible.

### **How to Apply**

- 1. Read all instructions completely and thoroughly.
- Fill out the application and submit the following supporting documents. (Documents must be unstapled and typed or legibly written):
  - An official copy of your most recent school transcript including your GPA and ACT or SAT scores (if applicable).

    A letter of recommendation prepared by a school official who is close to the applicant through class work or extracurricular activities OR by an employer/supervisor of the applicant from a job or community activity.
  - A one-page essay that answers the essay question found in the following application.
- 3. Submit the completed and unstapled application and documents to any SIU Credit Union branch or mail to:

### Your Application Will Not Be Considered If It Is:

- Late Application and supporting documents must be postmarked by March 31, 2023.
- Incomplete Applications must be completely filled out and sent with ALL supporting documents; incomplete applications will be filed with no action taken.
- Unqualified Applicants must meet ALL of the eligibility requirements (see above).
